

# Huccorgne Formation - HUC

**Authors:** Coen-Aubert & Lacroix, 1985, 1999d.

**Description:** The lower part, Biénonsart Member, consists of dark bioclastic bedded coral limestones; the overlying Robiewez Mbr is a thin bedded light-grey micritic limestone, often dolomitic; the Mehaigne Mbr consists chiefly of dark bedded limestones with stromatoporoid and colonial rugose corals.

**Stratotypes:** different outcrops east of Huccorgne.

**Area:** Eastern part of the northern border of the Namur Synclinorium.

**Thickness:** about 75 m in the type area.

**Age:** Middle Frasnian, probably lower part of *hassisi* conodont Zone to early *rhenana* Zone (Coen-Aubert & Lacroix, 1999).
