## 5.34 Lens Formation - LEN

### Carboniferous

**Authors:** Groessens et al., 1982; Paproth et al., 1983; Conil & Delcourt, 1989; Doremus & Hennebert, 1995a, 1995b; Hennebert, 1999.

**Description:** Generally pale, grey-blue to brownish grey, thick-bedded, fine- to coarse-grained, crinoidal and paleocrinoidal limestones. There is a rich macrofauna (*Megachonetes*, productids, *Syringopora*, gastropods). Dolomitic levels and chert occur at the base; oolitic levels in the upper part.

**Stratotype:** Old quarry and some exposures at Lens.

**Area:** Western HSA, at least from Péruwelz to Seneffe.

**Thickness:** 250 m in the type area.

**Age:** Moliniacian (Groessens et al., 1982).

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
